



INTERNSHIP INFORMATION AND FAQ'S

To help 17-24 year old's who are curious about vocational ministry see what serving in church leadership is like.

- Various hours during the week to complete tactics and projects

FAQ

Who should apply?

This internship is designed to help young adults explore what serving in a church is like. Anyone who is a Christian and has an interest in potentially serving in ministry in the future is encouraged to apply.

What is the application process?

First, complete the written application available on the Grace website. Applicants will then interview with a group of staff leaders from Grace. It is designed to replicate what your interview process will be like for church positions in the future.

When does it start and end?

The first day is Tuesday, June 11 and the final day is Sunday, August 4.

What would I do as an intern?

All interns will begin the summer going through a self-assessment of what ministry skills and passions they have, which will guide their experiences. Some interns will teach, lead worship at events, or other ministry tasks. All interns will complete learning assignments and prayer projects designed to help them process their experience in ministry with God. Additionally, they will assist with the church's ministry throughout the summer.

What is the compensation?

Each intern will receive \$800 for the internship.

My family is going on a vacation for one of those weeks. Can I still do the internship?

Yes. Interns may miss up to one week and still be eligible to participate. You will need to plan ahead to cover your responsibilities and debrief afterward what happened when you weren't there.
